How?

The Teacher Academy on Sustainable Communication wants to:

- develop competences of teachers in sustainable communication and enroll in a joint training programme of 20 ECTS on sustainable communication.
- enable teachers to grow in digital skills and the use of digital tools in sustainable communication.
- enable and fully integrate virtual, blended and physical mobility models in initial teacher education and continuing professional development education in a green and inclusive way.
- develop a European sustained and structured partnership between the providers of initial teacher education and continuous professional development.
- formulate guidelines for policymakers to implement sustainable communication as a crucial cross-cutting competence for teachers and teacher trainers.

Communities of Practice – CoP

- JOIN a gender balanced group of teachers from preschool and primary and lower secondary education who share your passion for sustainable communication.
- The CoP is an advisory, participative and action orientated board.
- Benefit from both individual growth and collective learning within your CoP.
- National CoP = work together with 25 teachers from your own country
- EU CoP = connect with at least 20 teachers of the 6 other TASC countries within the EU.
